

Sec. 22a-50-5. Classification criteria

The Commissioner may classify a pesticide restricted when:

- (a) the pesticide is intended or labelled for professional use
- (b) the pesticide is intended or labelled exclusively for aquatic use
- (c) a pesticide used indoors meets one or more of the following criteria:

- (1) Oral LD_{50} \leq 500 mg/kg (product as sold except "Ready-to-Use")
 \leq 2000 mg/kg (use dilution or "Ready-to-Use")

or

- (2) Dermal LD_{50} \leq 2000 mg/kg (product as sold except "Ready-to-Use")
 \leq 5000 mg/kg (use dilution or "Ready-to-Use")

or

- (3) Dust or mist acute inhalation LC_{50} (1 hr. exposure; 14 days observation) \leq 20 mg/l

or

- (4) Gas or vapor inhalation LC_{50} (1 hr. exposure; 14 days observation) \leq 2000 ppm

(d) a pesticide used outdoors or in agriculture meets one or more of the following criteria:

- (1) Oral LD_{50} \leq 50 mg/kg (products as sold except "Ready-to-Use")
 \leq 200 mg/kg (use dilution or "Ready-to-Use")

or

- (2) Dermal LD_{50} \leq 500 mg/kg (product as sold except "Ready-to-Use")
 \leq 1000 mg/kg (use dilution or "Ready-to-Use")

or

- (3) Build up of residues of ingredients or break-down products in mammalian or avian food in amounts \leq 1/5 LD_{50} following application.
