REVISED NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND REGULATION

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to Section 14-37a of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend sections 14-37a-1, 14-37a-3 and 14-37a-6 to 14-37a-7, inclusive, of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Statement of Purpose: The changes to the department's regulation concerning special operator's permits are required to implement recent statutory changes mandated by Public Act 2013-271. They allow a private occupational school student to apply for and receive a special education permit for the operation of a motor vehicle for the exclusive purpose of driving to and from such private occupational school. They also clarify the eligibility requirements for such an education permit. Further changes have been made to streamline the regulation and remove obsolete language.
