Department of Consumer Protection “**MEDICAL MARIJUANA LABORATORY TESTING**” The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended in Section 21a-408-60. (CLJ Notice Date: 12/29/2021, A.G. Approval Date: 3/29/2022 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 6/9/2022).

The above-captioned regulation was **LRRC - Approved with Technical Corrections** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 5/24/2022. The action was based on the recommendations of the Legislative Commissioners’ Office. The necessary corrections are outlined in the attached report.

After the necessary changes have been made, each agency must file a certified electronic copy of the regulation, accompanied by a certification statement from the agency head, with the Office of the Secretary of the State within fourteen days of its approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. If, for any reason, the agency fails to file the regulation in the prescribed time, it must notify the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the reasons for such failure within five days of the missed filing deadline.
