



NOTICE OF INTENT

In accordance with the provisions of § 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes (“C.G.S.”), the **Department of Administrative Services** (“DAS”) hereby gives notice that it proposes to adopt regulations concerning the **Administration of Grants for School Building Projects**.

COMMENT PERIOD

A comment period of not less than thirty days shall begin upon posting of this notice to the eRegulations System website and shall end on **May 16, 2025**.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

These proposed regulations amend §§ 10-287c-1 and 10-287c-23, add several new sections, and repeal §§ 10-287c-2 through 10-287c-22 in order to: (1) update references to agency names throughout; (2) remove sections and references to statutory provisions that have been repealed; (3) add new sections that more closely match and better articulate administration of the grants program, including application, plan review, reimbursement and record retention requirements; and (4) add a provision creating a maximum allowable cost per square foot as directed by C.G.S. § 10-284(a)(5).

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

To update the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies regarding certain grants for school building projects, currently within §§ 10-287c-1 through 10-287c-23, inclusive, as directed by C.G.S. § 10-287c, recently amended by Public Act 24-151.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

C.G.S. § 10-287c
