“ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS AND PRIVATE SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS” The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended by adding Sections 28-27-1a to 28-27-32a and repealing Sections 28-27-1 to 28-27-29, inclusive. (CLJ Notice Date: 10/19/2018, A.G. Approval Date: 9/18/2019 - Bearing a Deadline Date of 11/5/2019).

The above captioned regulation was **LRRC - Approved with Technical Corrections & Substitute Pages** by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee on 10/22/2019. The necessary corrections are outlined in the attached report from the Legislative Commissioners' Office.

After the necessary changes have been made, each agency must file a certified electronic copy of the regulation, accompanied by a certification statement from the agency head, with the Office of the Secretary of the State within fourteen days of its approval by the Legislative Regulation Review Committee. If, for any reason, the agency fails to file the regulation in the prescribed time, it must notify the Legislative Regulation Review Committee of the reasons for such failure within five days of the missed filing deadline.
