Concerning
Swimming Pool Assembler's License Application

The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies are amended by adding Section 20-340e-1 as follows:

(NEW) Sec. 20-340e-1. Application

(a) Any person seeking a swimming pool assembler's license shall apply to the Commissioner of Consumer Protection on an application form provided by the Commissioner.

(b) Each application for licensure shall be accompanied by:

(1) submission of satisfactory evidence that the applicant holds a valid home improvement contractor registration pursuant to the provisions of chapter 400 of the Connecticut General Statutes, or that the applicant works for an employer that holds a valid home improvement contractor registration, and

(2) the property addresses for at least two (2) above-ground swimming pools assembled by the applicant in the past five (5) years.

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Statement of Purpose

- (A) The purpose of this regulation is to clarify submission requirements associated with obtaining a swimming pool assembler's license from the Department of Consumer Protection.
- (B) This regulation instructs applicants and licensees where they may apply for a license and the qualifications required in order to obtain such license.
- (C) The regulation sets standards for the application process to obtain a swimming pool assembler's license, which is part of the regulatory structure of the Department of Consumer Protection.
