**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND REGULATIONS**

In accordance with the authority granted in Sections 4-168 and 20-340e of the Connecticut General Statutes, it is the intention of the State of Connecticut, Department of Consumer Protection to amend the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies by adding Section 20-340e-1, concerning Swimming Pool Assembler's License Application.

All interested parties who wish to submit data, views or arguments may do so in writing within thirty (30) days following the publication of this notice. The purpose of this regulation is to clarify submission requirements associated with obtaining a swimming pool assembler's license from the Department of Consumer Protection.

This regulation instructs applicants and licensees where they may apply for a license and the qualifications required in order to obtain such license.

The regulation sets standards for the application process to obtain a swimming pool assembler's license, which is part of the regulatory structure of the Department of Consumer Protection.
